CRS are recovering individuals in the community who work with drug and alcohol clients on a peer to peer basis. The primary function of the CRS is to help individuals gain access to needed resources in the community by assisting them in overcoming barriers and helping them bridge gaps between their needs and available resources.

Effective April 1, 2017, the Certified Recovery Specialist (CRS) credential will require the person applying for the CRS to have lived experience, to attest that they have had 18 months, in a continuous manner, of personal lived recovery experience, and to provide a statement of lived experience as part of the CRS application process
